

Level 2 (National) Umpire

A Level 2 umpire is certified to officiate at all club, local, provincial, and national events.



Level 2 Accreditation Process

Level 1 umpires can qualify for Level 2 (National) status after officiating for a minimum of 12 months and after at least 25 hours of umpiring experience at club, local and/or provincial tournaments (including their apprenticeship). All umpires are encouraged to keep a log of their officiating activities so that they are able to demonstrate their experience. A Level 1 umpire must take a measuring exam and pass with a mark of 90% or better in order to qualify as a Level 2 (National) umpire.

Re-certification

Existing Level 2 umpires, before 2015, are currently certified for a period of three (3) years. In order to be re-certified they should pass the measuring exam again. In order to transition to a 4-year re-certification period, Level 2 umpires will be asked to produce a log showing a minimum of 25 umpiring hours as well.
