NCCP Accreditation Available

The highest level of accreditation for Bowls Club Coach is **NCCP TRAINED**. Coaches can achieve this status by completing the one-day workshop: **Bowls Club Coach**.

Club Coach Workshop Outline

- Practice Coaching 1 emphasis on organization and set up to accomplish a goal (60 minutes)
- * Practice Coaching 2 emphasis on teaching skills to real participants and delivering effective communication/feedback (60 minutes)
- * NOTE: This workshop is NOT intended to be a skills clinic for bowlers looking to upgrade their playing skills and technique



PURPOSE

This workshop is designed for the coach who will be working with a wide range of bowlers who are competing in club tournaments and possibly playing in provincial play-down events.



NCCP Accreditation Available

There are two statuses available for coaches:

- 1. Trained
- 2. Certified



TRAINED status is achieved after successful completion of:

- Bowls Competition Coach Workshop,
- Multi-sport Make Ethical Decisions workshop, and
- Multi-Sport Teaching and Learning Workshop.



CERTIFIED status is available after the coach has successfully completed

- Bowls Competition Coach Portfolio,
- Formal evaluation in a bowls coaching environment,
- AND CAC's online evaluation for Make Ethical Decisions.



Bowls Specific Training Workshop:

- * Long-Term Athlete Development
- * Performance Analysis
- * Practice Planning
- * Teaching and implementing basic tactics and strategy





Training vs. Certification



Maintenance of Certification Policy

- NCCP certification valid for maximum 5 years
- Maintenance must be based on active coaching and professional development



POLICY ON RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATION AND PD

- PD is required to renew "certified" status in any context or gradation
- PD requirements must be completed by end of the period (5yrs)
- NSOs may require coaches to renew"trained" status through PD
- •NCCP minimum standards for **number** of PD **credits** by context
- NSOs may require more
